


The Pere Marquette River, part of the National Wild and Scenic Rivers System and a Blue Ribbon fishery, offers excellent fly-fishing for trout or salmon depending on the season.

Within a few minutes drive, the Lake County area offers golf and additional hiking through the Manistee National Forest. Kayaks are available for rent from an outside vendor, with portage to and from River Ranch.



Directions from Baldwin: Going north on M37 (Michigan Avenue), turn left on Seventh Street to the end (Cherry Street). Turn left on Cherry Street then right on 52nd Ave. Follow it until it forks to the left (56 St.). Follow 56th until you approach South Mack Road. Turn right onto South Mack Road and follow it to the River Ranch entrance.

The two-story, Adirondack-style cabin, is filled with rustic charm. The double-story main room is anchored by a magnificent wood-burning fieldstone fireplace and is a welcome place to gather your family or small group.

The lodge offers six bedrooms, four full baths and two half baths. We accept reservations for up to eight guests.

There is a separate recreation building, the tackle house, which could be used for card games and has equipment for shuffleboard and croquet. The tackles house features two full bathrooms.

Canoes, paddles and flotation cushions are available for guests use.



Without leaving the property, you could enjoy fishing, extensive hikes and canoe trips on the river, which may reveal deer, wild turkeys, blue herons, trout, salmon and other wildlife.
